The invitation is open to students and young managers (18-35), in teams comprised of 2-3 members, from across the world. **The winners will attend free-of-charge and present their project at the GRLI Assembly in Australia 2-4 March 2011.**

The winning team will be invited, all travel and accommodation paid, to present their project to the 10th GRLI General Assembly in Melbourne, Australia in March 2011. This will include:

1. Airfare for the 2 or 3-member team to Melbourne, Australia;
2. Cost of visa and Fee waiver of the registration fee;
3. Transportation to and from airports in home city and Melbourne;
4. Hotel accommodations for the 5 nights of the General Assembly;

All together, a price with a value of more than €15,000!
Additionally, the winning team will have their project showcased in *Global Responsibility*, the GRLI Partner Magazine as well as other channels.
